



Policy Workshop Belgium

Brussels, 22/2/2023

During the Policy Workshop organised by OBESSU, the following key points emerged.

- **Teacher Training and Networks:**
 - Offering additional compensation for teachers who undergo training, teach citizenship education classes, and dedicate extra time to such initiatives.
 - Conducting workshops to explore innovative methods of teaching citizenship education.
- **School Management:**
 - Adhering to both national and international guidelines for citizenship education within schools.
 - Regularly inviting professionals to provide ongoing training sessions for teachers at schools.
- **National Policymakers:**
 - Harmonizing citizenship education curricula between Vocational Education and Training (VET) and other high schools (regular education).
 - Placing increased emphasis on collecting and incorporating students' feedback in policy decisions.
- **EU Institutions:**
 - Organizing roundtable discussions with Members of the European Parliament (MEPs) and student councils.
 - Establishing specific guidelines for citizenship education in the EU, regularly reviewing and providing feedback on their implementation.
